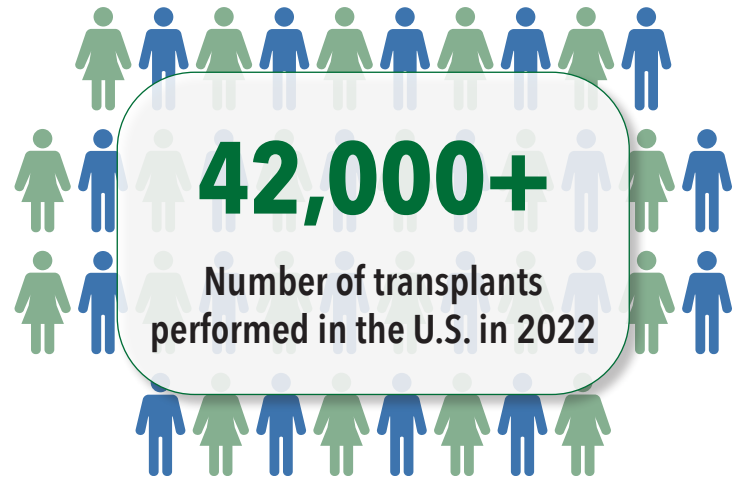
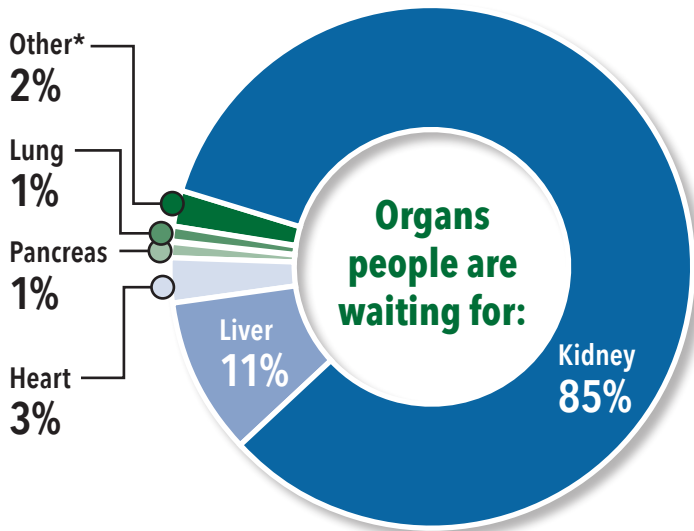


APRIL IS NATIONAL DONATE LIFE MONTH

Every year, thousands of Americans receive an organ, eye or tissue transplant.

As of January, there were 104,234 people on the national transplant waiting list; in Arkansas, there were about 300.



Every 10 minutes, another person is added to the transplant list.



More than 84,000 corneal transplants help to restore sight each year.



62% of Arkansans are registered as organ donors, the 16th-highest registration in the U.S.



Organ donation saves lives.

Up to eight lives can be saved from one deceased organ donor (including the heart, lungs, pancreas, kidneys, liver and intestines), and one organ, eye and tissue donor can save and heal **more than 75 lives**.
